Wriothesley is incredibly busy while simultaneously incredibly chill and calm. So while he has very good manners, occasionally, that combination will result in burps slipping out. He's the type to accidentally swallow a lot of air when speaking for long periods of time. When speaking to any of his subordinates, if he feels a bubble rising in his chest, he'll hold a hand over his mouth and turn his head as he either swallows it back down or tries to do a really subtle muffled burp that you won't even notice at a glance. Then he'll go back to business as usual.

If he's just in his office and someone's with him and a burp starts to build, most times, he'll do the same thing. But if he drank something a little faster than he normally would, he won't be able to be subtle about it. In those instances, a short but rather audible burp can be heard reverberating from behind his lips as he huffs and quickly excuses himself before going back at it. He doesn't get embarrassed by it and doesn't ever shame anybody else for accidentally burping around him either as he'll quickly insist that it's just a natural bodily function.

He actually DOES know how to burp on command, but it's not because he's immature or trying to be obnoxious. Air builds up in his stomach a lot, which has been known to give him an upset stomach. So, if he feels pressure brewing, he'll excuse himself from any company he's around until he's either in his office or the restroom, where he'll gulp down some air, push a fist against his mouth, and muffle an incredibly deep belch.

That's the other thing with Wriothesley. Due to his broad, firm body, his burps tend to be on the DEEP side. So even when he muffles them, you can hear them reverberating pretty heavily, and often on the forceful side. Especially if he's full.

Wriothesley, in his nature, is not a gluttonous person, but because he tends to do a lot for his people, he's been prone to skipping meals every now and then. And every time he does, he often tends to overdo it with his next meal. Sometimes, that means eating a lot faster than he's prone to, which once again makes him swallow a lot of air on top of having a full stomach. When that happens, his stomach will only be ever so slightly bloated, but his burps get much deeper and much harder to hold in. In instances like that, a burp or two may slip out of him, and when they do, you can hear just how forceful they can get.

If Wriothesley ever burps out loud, they're going to be *deep*. Usually, if they're strong enough to slip past his lips, they're from the deepest depths of his stomach with a lot of air or gas to back them up. If he ate heavily but just ate a little too fast, he'll simply excuse himself. But when he's genuinely eaten a lot more than he's used to and ends up noticeably bloated, then when he burps, those are gonna have some serious rumble and heft to them. Not being long or loud, but rather, forceful. And when he's bloated and lets a strong one like that out, he'll simply groan and rub his distended belly up and down in relief.
